

S.S. MANAPOURI

At 1,783 tons, the Manapouri was the first of a number of steamships purpose built by the Union Steamship Company of New Zealand for their passenger trade. Commissioned in May 1882, she was just approaching fourth year at the time of this voyage by the Rawlings family in steerage from Melbourne to Auckland.

Commander: Captain Thomas Logan

Sailed from Melbourne Tuesday, January 26, 1886;
